

Items around the home that can support Maths and Literacy

Maths resources may include:

- Resources for sorting and matching (colour, shape, size).
- Money resources (coins, purses, cash register etc).
- Numbers.
- Number lines.
- Clocks.
- Egg timers.
- Dice.
- Dominos.
- Playing cards.
- Weighing scales (traditional).
- Measuring cups and spoons
- Measuring tapes and rulers.
- Weighted resources to encourage mathematical language.
- Puzzles.

Literacy resources may include:

- Variety of mark making resources (pens, pencils, crayons).
- Natural mark makers (sticks, feathers).
- A variety of writing surfaces (paper, lined/graph paper, chalk/white boards).
- Letters (flashcards, magnetic letters and boards) in relevant languages.
- Labelling (children's names, words for children to copy).
- Rhyming resources.
- Literacy games.
- Clipboards.
- Books, magazines, comics, building instructions .
- Comparing print on packaging
